- ◆ Total pins + Handicap determines winners

12 & Over*

Boys & Girls' – Handicap & Scratch**

- ◆ Bowl 3 games of qualifying Saturday
- ◆ Top 24 return Sunday to bowl 3 game Semifinal Round
- ◆ 6 highest accumulated scores in each division advance to a stepladder Final Round to determine winners (accumulated scores are dropped prior to stepladder)
- ◆ SCRATCH DIVISION ONLY will bowl on 2 different Junior Gold Patterns; one pattern Saturday, a different pattern Sunday

**Age determined as of August 1, 2011. **Scratch Division winners also earn paid entry to North Pointe Jr. Gold in Indianapolis, IN. Handicap division winners DO NOT advance to a National Tournament. Bowlers can enter ONLY ONE division.*

ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY 15 FEBRUARY 2012.

This entry form can be turned in to your local Youth Director or you can mail it in individually. Entries will not be processed until payment is received. Make checks or money orders payable to Tennessee USBC Youth.

The Average deadline is 1 February 2012. **You must have a current standing sheet submitted with this entry.** A current standing sheet will reflect the latest scores bowled through 1 February 2012. You must use your highest current average. If you bowl on more than one league, you will need to use the standing sheet with your highest average over 9 games. If you bowl in a split season league that does not carry-over your scores for average, you will need to send in the season-ending standing sheet.

The player roster and squads will be posted on TN USBC Youth Pepsi Tournament group on weplay.com and on the tsyaba.com site.

PLEASE CIRCLE ONE DIVISION YOU ARE BOWLING IN. YOU CAN ONLY BOWL IN ONE DIVISION. The divisions are based on age, and there are no exceptions. The age is based on what the bowler's age was as of 1 August 2011.

2012 Tennessee State Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Rules & Format

1. AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED WITH STANDING SHEET. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT STANDING SHEET. Average used shall be bowler's highest USBC certified league average as of 1 February 2012 (this means after any games you may bowl that day) with nine (9) games or more. Bowlers who do not meet the average requirements will use their current average of at least nine (9) games prior to their participation in the tournament. All others must bowl scratch.
2. Competition will be conducted in six (6) divisions: Ages 11 & Under Boys' and Girls' Handicap; Ages 12 & Over Boys' and Girls' Handicap and Scratch. Age as of 1 August 2011. Any player with a 211 or higher entering average MUST enter the Scratch Division. Athletes are not mandated to be USBC Junior Gold Program Members to enter the Scratch Division. However, athletes must be program members or be eligible and buy membership prior to advancement to the North Pointe Junior Gold Championships.
3. Handicap will be 100% of 210.
4. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by the rules of USBC. Certificate #04498.
5. One time entry. Everyone who enters league level competition will advance to the state level. All checks are subject to a \$30.00 return fee.
6. Advancers out of the league level must remain in the division they qualified in during all subsequent levels. If a bowler advances out of the league level in more than one state/zone, the bowler must declare one state/zone to continue competing before the next competition level. HOWEVER, Tennessee does not run league qualifiers for this tournament. It is run as an open tournament. Anyone who bowls in Tennessee can compete if they are declaring Tennessee as their given state/zone.
7. Participants in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state/zone will result in automatic disqualification.

9. **Entry Closing Date is 15 February 2012.** Names of qualifiers along with State Pepsi Tournament entry fee for all qualifiers must be postmarked to the Tournament Director by this date.
TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD 17-18 MARCH 2012. No late entries will be accepted. No entries will be final until fees are collected.

10. Scholarship money will be returned 100%. USBC SMART Program contact: USBC Headquarters, 1.800.514.2695. Account #8547
11. Ages 11 and Under will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes 17 March 2012. Total pins with handicap will determine winner.
12. Ages 12 and Over Handicap divisions will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes 17 March 2012. Ages 12 and Over Scratch divisions will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes on 17 March 2012, at 7pm ONLY. The field will be cut to the top 24 bowlers in each division, and these athletes will return 18 March 2012 to bowl three (3) additional games on the same pair of lanes. Scores from qualifying carry over. The top six (6) bowlers in each division with the highest accumulated score will bowl a TV-Style Step-ladder roll-off to determine the winners. In case of a tie for the sixth position of the Step-Ladder, a one game roll-off will be completed to determine who

advances. All accumulated scores from previous rounds of qualifying will be dropped going in to the TV-Style Step-ladder roll-off. In case of a tie during the Step-ladder, a 9th & 10th frame roll-off (+1/10th of handicap per frame for Handicap Divisions) will be conducted until a winner is determined.

13. In the 12 and Over Scratch divisions, the bowlers will bowl on sport patterns throughout the tournament. Each day will have a different previous USBC Jr. Gold Tournament pattern for the Scratch Divisions only.
14. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No short skirts, short shorts, halter tops, or tank tops. No clothing or bowling equipment with tobacco or alcohol advertising will be allowed. This rule is under the tournament committee's discretion. The bowling center is a non-smoking facility. USBC youth bowlers participating in the tournament are not allowed to use tobacco or alcohol during their participation in the tournament.
15. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice.
16. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is their turn will be credited with a zero (0) for that frame.
17. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the settee area.
18. There will be no drinking or eating in the settee area.
19. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of the tournament or when awards are given out, whichever comes first. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours after competition ends. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
20. Trophies and scholarships will be awarded as follows: Top six (6) bowlers in each division.

In addition, the high scratch game and high handicap game each squad (boy and girl), will earn a \$100 scholarship. If there is a tie on any squad, the money for that squad will be split equally among the winners.

21. Special Scratch Awards (12 & Over Scratch Division): **NO EXPENSE PAID TRIP FOR SCRATCH WINNERS TO THE NORTH POINTE JUNIOR GOLD CHAMPIONSHIPS.** Top **TWO** highest finishing boy and girl in the scratch divisions will earn a paid berth to the 2012 North Pointe Junior Gold Championships in Indianapolis, IN, 14-20 July 2012. This does not include expenses. If any Junior Gold advancer is unwilling / unable to become a USBC Junior Gold Member or will not attend the championships, the athlete will still retain the state scholarship, but the berth to the championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete.
22. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Tennessee State Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
23. Please present each bowler with a copy of these rules. No money will be returned after received by the tournament director.
